**A BYLAW BEING ENACTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW 177/04,
BEING A BYLAW ENACTED TO ESTABLISH ANIMAL CONTROL**

WHEREAS Bylaw 177/04 was passed establishing animal control and licensing guidelines within Woodlands County;

AND WHEREAS the Council of Woodlands County deems it necessary to amend Bylaw 177/04 and, in particular, Schedule “B” thereof;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Woodlands County, duly assembled, enacts the following:

1. That Bylaw 177/04, and in particular Schedule “B” thereof, be and is hereby amended through the addition of ARE Districts – Agriculture Rural Estate District for areas south of the Athabasca River
2. That Bylaw 177/04 and amendments thereto shall, in all other respects, remain the same.

This Bylaw shall have force and take effect on the final reading thereof.

BOUNDARY AREAS

Bylaw No. 177/04 shall be in full force and effect within the following areas of Woodlands County:

A1 District	Agricultural (One) District – areas south of the Athabasca River
A2 District	Agricultural (Two) District – areas south of the Athabasca River
ARE District	Agricultural Rural Estate District - areas south of the Athabasca River
CR District	Country Residential District
CRR District	Country Residential Restricted District
CR1 District	Country Residential (One) District
RR District	Rural Recreational District
RMHP District	Rural Mobile Home Park District
