



## **TRANSFER SITE ID CARDS AVAILABLE for Goose Lake, Doris and Anselmo sites**

Woodlands County is pleased to announce that its new Transfer Site ID Card Program is underway.

At the May 19, 2009 council meeting, a policy was implemented to restrict the use of transfer stations in the county to only people who reside within the county itself.

As part of this program, numbered ID cards have been sent to residents. These cards will need to be presented to the transfer site operator before residents will be allowed to unload waste or recyclables.

The cards were designed to hang from the mirror inside vehicles to make it easy for residents to keep handy and in sight for the transfer site operators.

Any landowners who have not received their ID card are asked to go to either of the Woodlands County offices where they will be issued a card. Please bring proof of land ownership (i.e. tax certificate) when attending the offices to obtain an ID card.

Those who rent land must get the landowner to obtain their card on their behalf.

Second cards can be issued upon request.
