Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Area

The Timeu Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Area is located northeast of Fort Assiniboine on the north side of Secondary Highway 661. The area, composed of sandhills and intermittent wetlands, is about 38 square kilometres in size.

The area was identified through a public process to accommodate off-highway vehicle recreational activity; however, it is not designated under any legislation.
