
Title: Annual Roadside Cleanup Campaign

**Policy Statement:** Woodlands County endeavors to provide support to volunteer groups who wish to participate in the Annual Roadside Cleanup Campaign.

**Purpose:** Volunteer groups in Woodlands County can take pride in their efforts to enhance and beautify roadways in the County.

**Principles**: The County believes that this is an excellent means to offer financial support to volunteer groups for their endeavors.

- 1. Each year, on the first Saturday in May, volunteer groups across Alberta are encouraged to participate in the Annual Highway Cleanup Program presented by Alberta Transportation by cleaning debris on provincial roads.
- 2. In addition to the provincial roads, Council has authorized volunteer groups to clean debris from County managed roads from the first Saturday in May to the second Saturday in May inclusive.
- 3. All participating volunteer groups must have their "Road Managers" attend a mandatory training season put on by Infrastructure Services prior to the cleanup days. The training sessions will be held at the Woodlands County Regional Offices in Whitecourt and Fort Assiniboine.
- 4. Woodlands County will assign the roadway sections to the appropriate volunteer groups.
- 5. Volunteers will be covered under Woodlands County insurance policy for \$1,000,000.00 general liability. The general liability insurance covers property damage or third party injury for the specific cleanup days only.
- 6. Woodlands County will pay \$ 100.00 per kilometer (includes both sides) of roadway cleaned to each of the volunteer groups that participate in the cleanup.
