Policy Statement: To allow for approval of hauling overweight loads.

- 1. The County approves the hauling of overweight loads during certain times of the year, subject to the applicant having previously obtained an overweight permit from Alberta Motor Transport Services.
- 2. Overweight approvals will be issued in conjunction with the road-use approval for non-overweight loads on "Appendix A" of the yearly Road Use Agreement titled "Road Use Information Sheet" attached hereto.
- 3. All approvals will be issued by either the Chief Administrative Officer, the Director of Infrastructure Services or the Area Foreman and properly logged in accordance with "Appendix B" attached hereto.
- 4. Approvals for after-hours overweight hauling will be referred to the Foreman, or his authorized designate, responsible for the applicable area, whose number can be obtained by calling either office number and acquiring the on-call number for road use approvals.
