

**Title: Roadside Grass Seeding**

**Supersedes Policy No:**

**Policy Statement:** To discourage the growth of weeds, stop erosion, and provide for bank stabilization on local roadsides by grass seeding.

1. The County shall seed in grass all local roadsides disturbed by road construction or maintenance.
2. The mixture to be used on all roadside seeding shall be 5 – 1 – 1 Creeping Red Fescue, White Clover and Timothy respectively.
3. Seeding rates shall be 10 – 15 pounds per acre followed by a 100 – 150 pound per acre application of 28-26-0 fertilizers.
4. Wood waste sludge may be used in areas of high erosion in place of fertilizer.
