
Title: Gravel Policy No: 3205

Policy Statement: To outline the gravelling requirements for the Municipality.

- 1. Regular Road Gravelling:
 - a) Up to 160 cubic meters (250 tonne) per kilometer on local roads of ³/₄" gravel.
 - b) Should more gravel be required per kilometer, the Area Supervisor or Director of Infrastructure Services is authorized to provide necessary amounts.
 - c) The full County gravel road system is to be regraveled on a rotating 3year program as required and as deemed by the Director Infrastructure Services.
- 2. Construction Gravelling:
 - a) Initial Lift of 10 cm of $1\frac{1}{2}$ " shall be compacted into the road base surface, followed by 5 cm of compacted $\frac{3}{4}$ " crushed.
 - b) Approaches will be re-graveled during new construction or during the application of gravel to adjacent roads.
- 3. Residents requesting to purchase gravel from the County will be directed to purchase gravel from the private contractors in the area.
- 4. Requests by rural community halls, cemeteries and other institutions may be considered by Council.
- 5). Truckers, while working for the Municipality, are to travel at posted speed limits. Truckers are to use the roads courteously, considering such factors as privacy, noise levels and road conditions. A municipal employee may issue a warning to a non-complying operator. Repeat offenders may be suspended from further hauling.
